- say when you will need it.

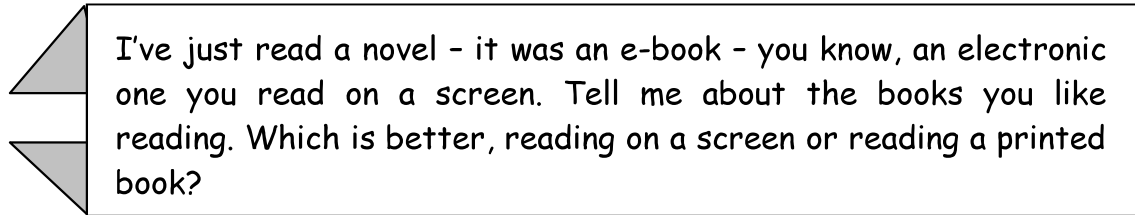
